## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing pursuant to Article 18-A of the New York General Municipal Law (the õActö) will be held by the Jefferson County Industrial Development Agency (the õAgencyö) on Thursday May 26, 2022 at 11:15 a.m. local time, at Town of Hounsfield Municipal Office, 18774 County Route 66, Salt Point Road, Watertown, New York 13601 in connection with the following matter:

DIGICOLLECT LLC, for itself and/or on behalf of an entity or entities to be formed (collectively, the õCompanyö), has submitted an application (the õApplicationö) to the Agency requesting the Agency's assistance with a certain project or projects (collectively, the õProjectö) consisting of: (i) the disposition by the Agency of all or portions of approximately 12.10 acres of real property owned by the Agency and located at 16904 State Route 12F in the Town of Hounsfield, Jefferson County, New York (the õLandö, being more particularly described as tax parcel No. 81.00-1-5), (ii) the phased planning, design, construction and operation of an approximately 50,000 square foot manufacturing facility for use by the Company to produce data sensors, monitors, data collection and storage and related software developed for renewable energy and utility usage, including building improvements for manufacturing, warehousing, office space, data storage and related internal spaces, external parking improvements, storm water management and related site improvements, and related on and offsite utility improvements (collectively, the õImprovementsö), and (iii) the acquisition in and around the Improvements and of certain items of equipment and other tangible personal property and equipment (the õEquipmentö and, collectively with the Land and the Improvements, the õFacilityö), and (iv) entering into a straight lease transaction (within the meaning of subdivision (15) of Section 854 of the Act), pursuant to which the Agency will retain a leasehold interest in the Facility for a period of time and sublease such interest in the Facility back to the Company (the õStraight Lease Transactionö).

The Agency is contemplating providing financial assistance to the Company with respect to the Project (the õFinancial Assistanceö) in the form of: (1) an exemption from all state and local sales and use taxes with respect to the qualifying personal property included in or incorporated into the Facility or used in the acquisition, renovation, reconstruction or equipping of the Facility, (2) an exemption from all mortgage recording taxes imposed on the Facility by the State of New York or any political subdivision thereof, and (3) an abatement or exemption from real property taxes levied against the Facility, pursuant to a Payment-In-Lieu-of-Tax Agreement to be entered into by and between the Company and the Agency (subject to compliance with the Agency policies with respect to Payment-in-Lieu-of-Tax Agreements).

In accordance with Section 859-a of the Act, a representative of the Agency will be at the above-stated time and place to present a copy of the Company® Project Application (including a cost-benefit analysis), which is also available for viewing on the Agency® website at: <a href="www.jcida.com">www.jcida.com</a>. Interested parties will be provided a reasonable opportunity, both orally and in writing, to present their views with respect to the Project.
