- I. Call to Order:** Chairman Aliasso called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m.

 - a. Ag –** Mr. Matteson handed out his monthly report. Topics discussed as follows:
 - **Budget Development** – the entire team did a tremendous amount of work developing the budget.
 - **County Board of Legislators Presentation** - we are working on a presentation for the County Board of Legislators scheduled for September 8th regarding the budget request.
 - **Electrical Infrastructure/National Grid** – had a great meeting to discussing electrical upgrades/development in the county.
 - **Infrastructure** – there has been discussion across the county for ag related and other manufacturing related. The focus on infrastructure development is increasing and needs to increase even more in order for us to grow Jefferson County.

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- **Project Meadow** – he and Mr. Weir worked on a response to Empire State Development’s RFI for a manufacturing operation looking for a site.
 - **Chobani/Dairy Processing Intelligence** – announced another plant that will be built in Allentown, Pennsylvania. It will be a second major development in the dairy industry and will impact all of NYS.
- b. Manufacturing** – Mr. Weir announced that Manufacturing Day will be held on October 16th. He said students will tour manufacturing sites such as New York Air Brake for a day in the life experience.
